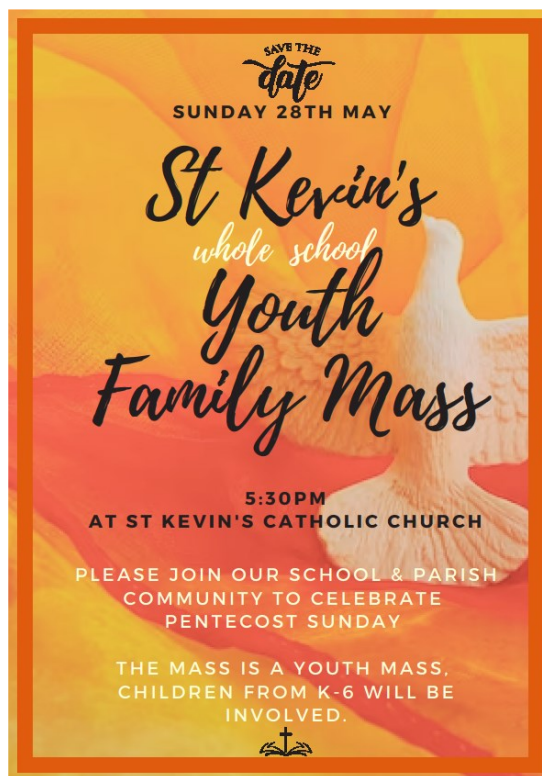


### The Month of May

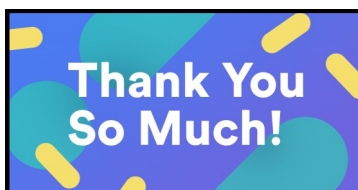

# SCRIPTURE READINGS

## Entrance Antiphon

A reading from the Acts of the Apostles

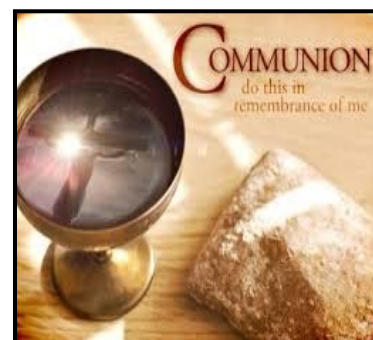
