

Do you wonder how Abraham knew straight away that his three visitors represented God? Somehow, he knew that in their presence he was in the presence of God. Abraham and Sarah were no strangers to suffering and neither was Paul. Somehow Paul knew that God's presence was in the suffering, and that this hidden mystery was now being revealed in Christ. *The mystery is* Christ *among you*!

Mary and Martha also came to learn this in a particular way. As it was for Abraham and Paul, Jesus teaches them that all serving must be grounded in a deep relationship of love with God. The presence of God is already with us, in the mystery of Christ. We just need to be open to knowing it, in all that we do. Just for today then, what would it be like to run to serve a

stranger as if you were meeting God? How will you sit at the feet of Jesus?

First Reading

Genesis 18:1-10

A reading from the book of Genesis The Lord appeared to Abraham at the Oak of Mamre while he was sitting by the entrance of the tent during the hottest part of the day. He looked up, and there he saw three men standing near him. As soon as he saw them he ran from the entrance of the tent to meet them, and bowed to the ground. 'My Lord,' he said 'I beg you, if I find favour with you, kindly do not pass your servant by. A little water shall be brought; you shall wash your feet and lie down under the tree. Let me fetch a little bread and you shall refresh yourselves before going further. That is why you have come in your servant's direction.' They replied, 'Do as you say.'

Abraham hastened to the tent to find Sarah. 'Hurry,' he said 'knead three bushels of flour and make loaves.' Then running to the cattle Abraham took a fine and tender calf and gave it to the servant, who hurried to prepare it. 
