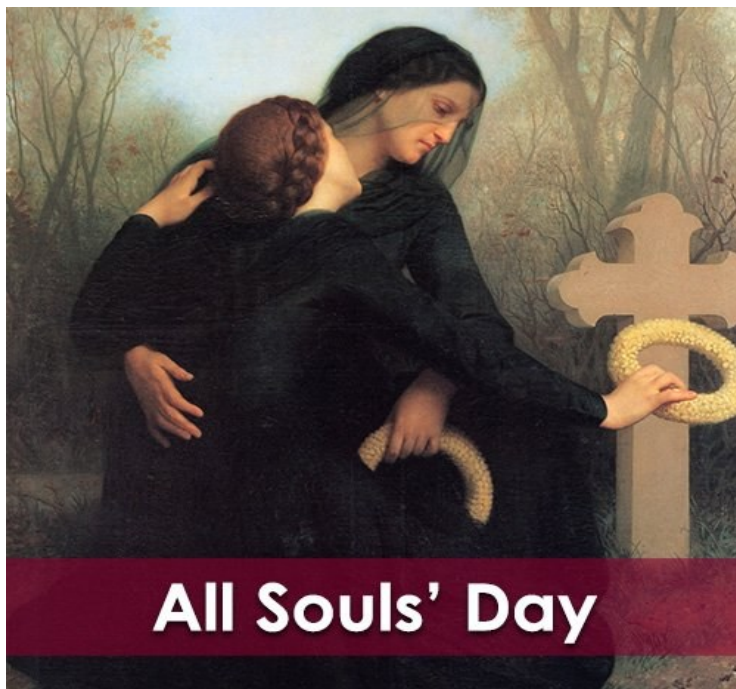

Catechists/Special Religious Educators (SRE) are being asked to teach 27 classes in 4 primary schools and Manly Selective High for our parish.

Do we have enough volunteers?

No, we need more teachers both in the primary and secondary schools.

What's the commitment per class?

About 40 mins at the school plus preparation time over school terms. Maybe you would like to assist as a helper for a term or so to find out more.

Can you take time off during term if needed?

Yes – holidays and time off both are part of SRE.

What days are the lessons?

Tuesday or Thursday afternoons, Wed. morning

Student textbooks? Yes - & teaching manual + USB containing all the lessons, pictures & songs.

Training? 8 x 2hr sessions online or face to face over one year. Time in class with another catechist.

Working with children check compulsory?

Of course, but online application is easy.

How many parishioners are in this ministry?

A reading from the letter of St Paul to the Romans.

Hope is not deceptive, because the love of God has been poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit which has been given us. We were still helpless when at his appointed moment Christ died for sinful men. It is not easy to die even for a good man - though of course for someone really worthy, a man might be prepared to die - but what proves that God loves us is that Christ died for us while we were still sinners. Having died to make us righteous, is it likely that he would now fail to save us from God's anger? When we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, we were still enemies; now that we have been reconciled, surely we may count on being saved by the life of his Son? Not merely because we have been reconciled but because we are filled with joyful trust in God, through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have already gained our reconciliation.

A reading from the holy Gospel according to Luke.

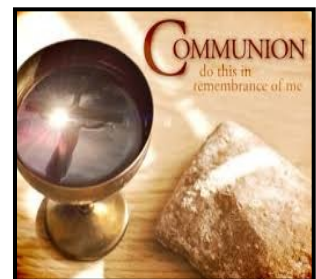
