### Parish Recycle Programme

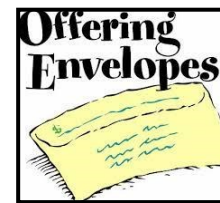
Recycling recently totalled **\$705**. We can only accept bottles with the 10 cent label. Thank you for your ongoing support.

the house-tops.

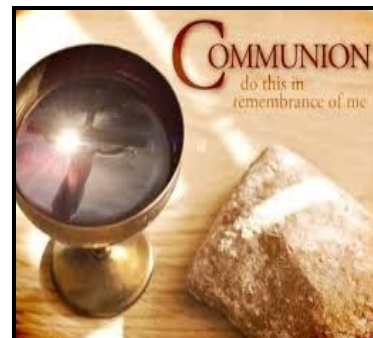
'Do not be afraid of those who kill the
