End of Pilgrimage

The Decree on the Granting of Indulgences during the Jubilee Year is as follows:

(1) All the faithful, are eligible to receive a plenary indulgence if they:

Are truly repentant and free from any affection for sin
Are moved by a spirit of charity

Are purified through the sacrament of penance and refreshed by Holy Communion, and Pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff.

(2) The faithful, pilgrims of hope, will be able to obtain the Jubilee Indulgence granted by the Holy Father if they undertake a pious pilgrimage to any Sacred Jubilee Site, and devoutly participating in Mass or other liturgical rites.

A plenary indulgence is a grace granted by the Catholic Church through the merits of Jesus Christ to remove the temporal punishment due to sin.

The indulgence applies to sins already forgiven. A plenary indulgence cleanses the soul as if the person had just been baptized. Plenary indulgences obtained during the Jubilee Year can also be applied to souls in purgatory with the possibility of obtaining two plenary indulgences for the deceased in one day, according to the Apostolic Penitentiary.

Each pilgrim will receive a Pilgrimage Passport. It will be stamped at all Jubilee Sites then all the names of the pilgrims will be submitted to the Diocesan Chancery after which an official CERTIFICATE of Pilgrimage will be issued by the Diocese of Broken Bay.

For those who are unable to join the Pilgrimage on 30th August, a Pilgrimage of Works of Mercy & Penance is being proposed to take place in St Kevin's Church on Thursday 27th November at 9am . More details to follow at a later date.

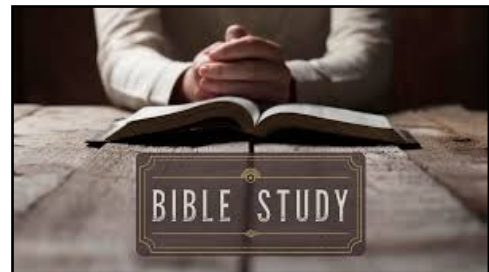

A reading from the letter of St Paul to
Colossians.

Since you have been brought back to
true life with Christ, you must look for
the things that are in heaven, where
Christ is, sitting at God's right hand.
Let your thoughts be on heavenly
things, not on the things that are on
the earth, because you have died, and
now the life you have is hidden with
Christ in God. But when Christ is
revealed - and he is your life - you too
will be revealed in all your glory with
him.

That is why you must kill everything in
you that belongs only to earthly life:
fornication, impurity, guilty passion,
evil desires and especially greed,
which is the same thing as
worshipping a false god; and never tell
each other lies. You have stripped off
your old behaviour with your old self,
and you have put on a new self which
will progress towards true knowledge
the more it is renewed in the image of
its creator; and, in that image there is
no room for distinction between Greek
and Jew, between the circumcised or
the uncircumcised, or between
barbarian and Scythian, slave and free
man. There is only Christ: he is
everything and he is in everything.

he replied 'who appointed me your

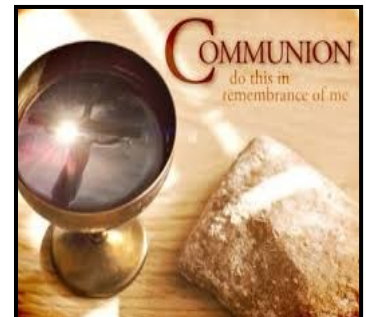
judge, or the arbitrator of your claims?'
