


Zacchaeus wanted to 'see' Jesus, while Jesus wanted to 'meet and stay' with Zacchaeus. The subtle difference in intent between Jesus and Zacchaeus has implications for our relationship with God. God wants to be engaged in our lives, to meet and stay with us where we are, sharing his forgiving love and presence. From a mere desire to see, Zacchaeus takes Jesus home, regardless of what others think. Without being asked, he declares that he will share his wealth with the poor, not out of selfish motives but obviously moved by Jesus' love.

We can learn much from Zacchaeus in our daily life. An effort to catch a glimpse of Jesus will have him waiting for us, inviting himself into our hearts. When we take one step towards God, he take several towards us. Do we still only want to 'see' Jesus or to 'meet' and be transformed by him forever?

Shrine to St John Paull II
And

The Diocese of Broken Bay now has Australia's first national Shrine to St John Paul II – but it is a Shrine for all of Australia. More than a thousand people gathered at St Patrick's Church, East Gosford last Saturday to celebrate the inauguration of the Shrine to St John Paul II and the installation of two first-class relics.

Bishop Anthony has said:

"I encourage people throughout the Diocese, and indeed right around the country, to visit the Shrine. Make this Shrine, this sanctuary of love, a place to intercede through St John Paul II for vocations, to the married life, to the consecrated life, to the single life and to the ordained priestly and deaconal life. This will become a great powerhouse to continue the wonderful work that is already happening in this Diocese and in the Church right across Australia"



Sacred Heart Mass




A reading from the holy Gospel according to Luke
