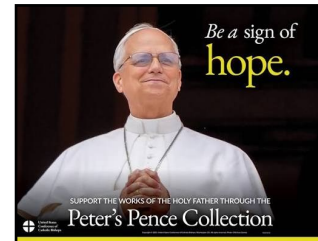

We also keep those tasked with appointing a new bishop in our prayers, that they will choose a fitting shepherd for the people of Broken Bay.

Father, just as no one knows the Father except the Son and those to whom the Son chooses to reveal him.

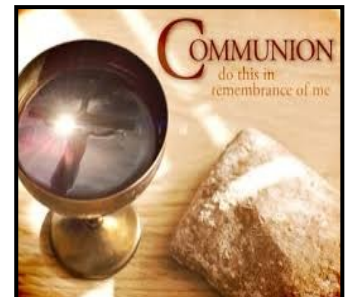
