face of the earth'.***

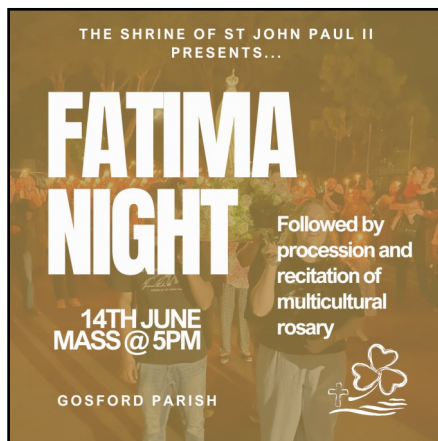

Lord, send forth your Spirit again to renew my own face in warm welcome and mercy towards others.



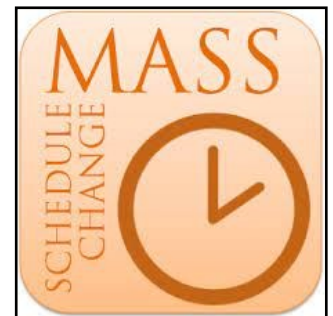
Upcoming Clergy

Vox Populi 05 June 2025

The season of Eastertide will come to a close this weekend, as the Church celebrates Pentecost and the beginning of Ordinary Time. Pentecost is the birth of the Church, following the Ascension of Jesus into heaven. It is the fulfilment of the promise of Jesus, that He would send them an advocate, the Holy Spirit, to guide the Church. Just as He promised, when the Apostles were gathered on the day of Pentecost, when there was a "mighty rushing wind" and "tongues as of fire" appeared. They were filled with the Holy Spirit, giving them the courage and strength to testify to the Gospel, and to spread the Good News far and wide, often facing martyrdom. As we celebrate Pentecost, this is not a time to return to the "ordinary" following the seasons of Lent and Easter. Rather, it is a time to be renewed by the Holy Spirit, and embody the missionary spirit of the early Church, which proudly and boldly proclaimed the Gospel. May the Holy Spirit renew us in our mission and lead us into a deeper relationship with God.

Entrance Antiphon

The Spirit of the Lord has filled the whole world and that which contains all things understands what is said, alleluia.

First Reading

Acts 2:1-11

A reading from the Acts of the Apostles.

When Pentecost day came round, the apostles had all met in one room, when suddenly they heard what sounded like a powerful wind from heaven, the noise of which filled the entire house in which they were sitting; and something appeared to them that seemed like tongues of fire; these separated and came to rest on the head of each of them. They were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and began to speak foreign languages as the Spirit gave them the gift of speech. Now there were devout men living in Jerusalem from every nation under heaven, and at this sound they all assembled, each one bewildered to hear these men speaking his own language. They were amazed and astonished. 'Surely' they said 'all these men speaking are Galileans? How does it happen that each of us hears them in his own native language? Parthians, Medes and Elamites; people from Mesopotamia, Judaea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya round Cyrene; as well as visitors from Rome - Jews and proselytes alike - Cretans and Arabs; we hear them preaching in our own language about the marvels of God.'

Second Reading

Romans 8:8-17

A reading from the letter of St Paul to the Romans.

People who are interested only in unspiritual things can never be pleasing to God. Your interests, however, are not in the unspiritual, but in the spiritual, since the Spirit of God has made his home in you. In fact, unless you possessed the Spirit of Christ you would not belong to him. Though your body may be dead it is because of sin, but if Christ is in you then your spirit is life itself because you have been justified; and if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, then he who raised Jesus from the dead will give life to your own mortal bodies through his Spirit living in you.

So then, my brothers, there is no necessity for us to obey our unspiritual selves or to live unspiritual lives. If you do live in that way, you are doomed to die; but if by the Spirit you put an end to the misdeeds of the body you will live.

Everyone moved by the Spirit is a son of God. The spirit you received is not the spirit of slaves bringing fear into your lives again; it is the spirit of sons, and it makes us cry out, 'Abba, Father!' The Spirit himself and our spirit bear witness that we are children of God. And if we are children we are heirs as well: heirs of God and coheirs

with Christ, sharing his sufferings so as to share his glory.

And my word is not my own; it is the word of the one who sent me.

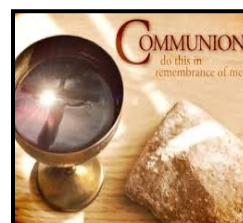
I have said these things to you while still with you; but the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all I have said to you.'
