




receiving Him, the Spirit creates unity among humankind. How the face of the earth could be changed by such openness.

*Lord,* send forth your Spirit again to renew my own face in warm welcome and mercy towards others.


# Upcoming Clergy Conference: Mass Time Changes

The season of Eastertide will come to a close this weekend, as the Church celebrates Pentecost and the beginning of Ordinary Time. Pentecost is the birth of the Church, following the Ascension of Jesus into heaven.

It is the fulfilment of the promise of Jesus, that He would send them an advocate, the Holy Spirit, to guide the Church. Just as He promised, when the Apostles were gathered on the day of Pentecost, when there was a "mighty rushing wind" and "tongues as of fire" appeared.

They were filled with the Holy Spirit, giving them the courage and strength to testify to the Gospel, and to spread the Good News far and wide, often facing martyrdom. As we celebrate Pentecost, this is not a time to return to the "ordinary" following the seasons of Lent and Easter. #### **Second Reading**

Romans 8:8-17

A reading from the letter of St Paul to the Romans.

People who are interested only in unspiritual things can never be pleasing to God. Your interests, however, are not in the unspiritual, but in the spiritual, since the Spirit of God has made his home in you. In fact, unless you possessed the Spirit of Christ you would not belong to him. Though your body may be dead it is because of sin, but if Christ is in you then your spirit is life itself because you have been justified; and if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, then he who raised Jesus from the dead will give life to your own mortal bodies through his Spirit living in you.

So then, my brothers, there is no necessity for us to obey our unspiritual selves or to live unspiritual lives. If you do live in that way, you are doomed to die; but if by the Spirit you put an end to the misdeeds of the body you will live

Everyone moved by the Spirit is a son of God. The spirit you received is not the spirit of slaves bringing fear into your lives again; it is the spirit of sons, and it makes us cry out, 'Abba, Father!' The Spirit himself and our spirit bear witness that we are children of God. And if we are children we are heirs as well: heirs of God and coheirs

with Christ, sharing his sufferings so as to share his glory.


