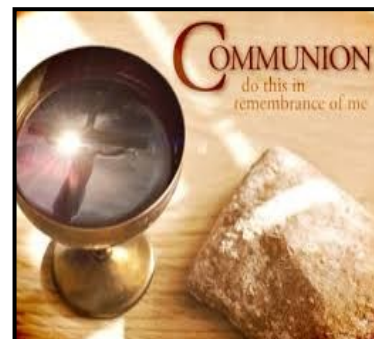
and no one knows the Son except the
