Gospel Reflection: Prior to commencing his public ministry, Christ was led into the wilderness for a period of forty days. This was a time of earnest prayer, of fasting, of confronting temptation and of a deeper encounter with the mysteries of silence, solitude and the self. As we arrive at the first Sunday of Lent, it is pertinent to consider how we may emulate our Lord's example. Let us permit ourselves to be drawn more deeply into our own personal desert, in the hidden and sacred solitude of the soul, and through the uncharted empty spaces of our hearts. For it is when we are most truly alone that we become most authentically ourselves. And it is when we become most authentically ourselves that we are closest to God. For the human solitude of the heart, and the divine solitude of God abide, unseen and unknown, in the same effable silence.

Excerpt from Pope Francis' Lenten Message 2020

In this Lent of 2020, I would like to share with every Christian what I wrote to young people in the Apostolic Exhortation Christus Vivit: "Keep your eyes fixed on the outstretched arms of Christ crucified, let yourself be saved over and over again. And when you go to confess your sins, believe firmly in his mercy which frees you of your guilt. Contemplate his blood poured out with such great love, and let yourself be cleansed by it. In this way, you can be reborn ever anew: (No. 123). Jesus's Pasch is not a past event; rather, through the power of the Holy Spirit it is every present, enabling us to see and touch with faith the flesh of Christ in those who suffer.

All Ministers of Communion (Ordinary and Extraordinary) are to be diligent in the use of hand sanitizer prior to the distribution of Communion.

Given the continuing level of public concern about the coronavirus, but in light of the fact that the virus is currently contained in Australia, Bishop Anthony instructs that the above principles be maintained in Diocese of Broken Bay until end March 2020. The situation will be constantly monitored.

WORLD DAY OF PRAYER 2020

World Day of Prayer (WDP) will be celebrated on Friday, 6th March. WDP is a global ecumenical movement led by Christian women who welcome us to join in prayer and action for peace and justice. It is now the largest ecumenical event in the world, supported by Catholic, Protestant, Orthodox and Evangelical churches. It is run under the motto "Informed Prayer and Prayerful Action" and is celebrated annually in over 170 countries on the first Friday in March. The movement is led by women but aims to bring together both men and women of various races, cultures and traditions in a yearly common Day of Prayer.

The World Day of Prayer 2020 host country is Zimbabwe and the theme is "Rise! Take your Mat and Walk!' The theme is grounded on Jesus' encounter with a person who, although positioned for healing, had not acted upon the opportunities given (John 5:2-9a). "Rise! Take Your Mat and Walk," said Jesus. WPD 2020 reminds us not to be afraid to act on the word of God.
