Dear Parishioners and visitors to the Parish,

Blessed John Henry Newman wrote: "God has created me to do Him some definite service. He has committed some work to me which He has not committed to another.... He has not created me for naught. I shall do good; I shall do his work." Each of us has a call and a purpose to fulfil as disciples of Christ. Identifying, acknowledging and honouring this purpose in God is perhaps the most important action a baptised disciple can take. Let us take the time to understand what we are here to do and then pursue that with passion and enthusiasm. This call implies a transformative personal experience with Jesus in a way that invites a free response.

Today in the first reading we hear the call of Isaiah who at first felt his unworthiness but with God's grace coming through the angel he was called to be a prophet to the nations and answered "Here I am, send me." In the Gospel we have the call of Peter who was called to be the first Pope. Jesus asked him to put his nets out into the deep when Peter's fishing experience said this would not make sense. But when he obeyed the Lord, he caught a huge catch of fish. Again, like Isaiah, Peter felt unworthy but Jesus said I will grace you to be my disciple as the first Pope and so you will now be a fisher of men. In your own way you are called to bring Christ to others. Mary was called to be the Mother of God. John the Baptist was called to prepare the way of the Lord. What is your call? With purpose, everything in life seems to fall into place. To be "on purpose" means you are doing what you love to do, doing what you're good at and accomplishing what is important to you. When you truly are on purpose, the people, resources and opportunities you need naturally gravitate towards you. The world benefits too, because when you act in alignment with your true life purpose, all of your actions automatically serve others. They will also be expressions of loving God in a way that is committed to his project of loving humans in the power of the Spirit. Remember the words of St John of the Cross: "In the eventide of life, you will be examined in love."

So, who is Jesus and you for each other? There is something particular for you in the answer which you need to take 100% responsibility for in the name of Jesus.

Affordable Housing Assembly Sydney Alliance, Vinnies NSW, and the Everybody's Home Campaign, are hosting an assembly on affordable housing at the Sydney Town Hall on 14<sup>th</sup> March 2019 from 6.30pm- 8.30pm, nine days before the NSW election. Affordable (rental) housing is housing that is appropriate for the needs of very low to moderate income households and is priced so that these households are able to meet other basic living costs, such as food, clothing, transport, medical care and education.

At the assembly decision makers will be asked to commit to a range of 'asks' around affordability. The assembly will also provide an opportunity to act upon the 2018 Social Justice Statement from Australia's bishops, "A Place to Call Home: Making A Home for Everyone in Our Land."
