Jesus returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the desert for forty days, to be tempted by the devil. (Gospel)

Dear Parishioners and visitors to the Parish,

Jesus 'was led by the Spirit through the wilderness' (Lk 4:1). The wilderness is a potent biblical image filled with intrigues and paradox. How is it that such a place—desolate, dangerous, lonely and lifethreatening—can also be the place of divine power, consolation, intimacy and transformation? This was true for our ancient ancestors in faith (recalled in today's first reading). The people of Israel were born amidst the divinely-led desert journeys and sojourns of Abraham and his expanding family. They were then trained into nationhood during a forty-year wilderness trek, led by Moses, out of Egypt to the land promised by God. How alive these ancestral stories must have been to Jesus as he encountered both temptation and empowerment in the wilderness, a Spirit-led experience which fuelled his public ministry (today's Gospel). What insights from these sacred texts can I glean for the unfolding, testing and enabling of my own life's journey as a member of God's people? During the wilderness periods that are an inevitable part of life, may I be ready for temptation and awake to the Spirit's presence.



The Parish Choir will be practicing for the Easter masses and would like to invite anyone with a love of singing to join them. The practices will be held in the Church at 7:30pm on:


