What is the Thirst of Jesus and how may we satiate it? When Jesus was on the cross he said, "I thirst." but what did he mean? What do you think he meant? Mother Teresa of Calcutta, now a saint, built her mission of charity spirituality for her sisters on the answer to the words of Jesus "I thirst." The short answer is that Jesus thirsts for love from each one of us and the salvation of all souls by showing us how to love one another just as Saint Teresa did by loving the poorest of the poor.

So a part of your identity and mine is to be a missionary disciple. Jesus said "Go make disciples of all nations and teach them all I taught you." This is to be understood in our own backyard and further afield. Today Fr John Hogarty, a Columban missionary, will speak to us on missionary activity. Our churches cannot survive if we simply aim at maintenance by looking after ourselves; we must outreach further afield in accordance with our identity. We may do this through our prayer and sacrifices using our God-given time and talents. St Therese and her sister Celine brought about the conversion of an unrepentant triple murderer simply through prayer and sacrifice in ordinary everyday life using their time and talent.

Remembrance Day. On the eleventh hour, of the eleventh day, of the eleventh month, one hundred years ago to the day an armistice was signed. It marked the end of World War I. So it is appropriate that we remember all those who have died in war or by violent means. We lovingly commit them to the Lord in order that they may experience the fullness of peace that only God can give. At the 10am mass we will play the Last Post followed by a minute's silence and then the Reverie to remember them. In gratitude they will be praying for us. May God bless you. Fr Greg Chee, OCD

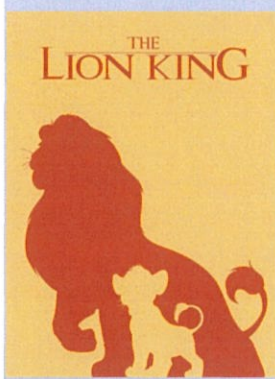

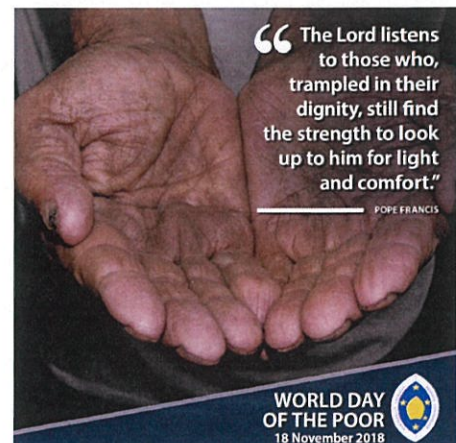

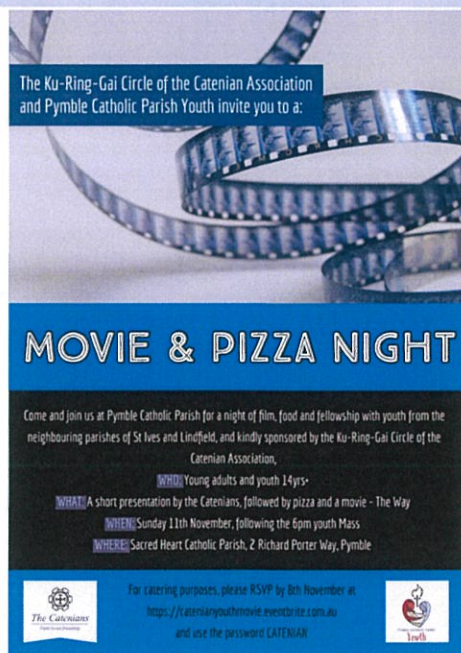
