Nevertheless, our every thought and deed, however mundane, if done with the intention of expressing the glory of God, can also become a true and genuine act of worship—a living sacrifice of praise, a passionate song of love, and even a heart-felt plea for forgiveness.

SOCIAL JUSTICE CORNER:

POVERTY IN AUSTRALIA

According to the 2020 Poverty in Australia Overview by the Australian Council of Social Service and UNSW Sydney, 3.24 million people in Australia are living below the poverty line. They include more than one in eight adults and one in six children.

The report's lead researcher, UNSW Sydney Associate Professor Dr Bruce Bradbury said: "The poverty rate in Australia is worse than in most other wealthy countries, including New Zealand, Germany and Ireland. Our report finds that 13.6 per cent of people in Australia are living in poverty and that poverty rates have remained at about this level for the past decade, despite economic growth. Child poverty has consistently been higher than overall poverty, ranging from 18 per cent to 16 per cent over the past decade and now sits at 17.7 per cent - more than one in six children." ACOSS has called on the government to boost growth in jobs, increase Newstart and Rent Assistance, and invest in social housing. For further info go to:
