Dear Parishioners and visitors to the Parish.

For a couple of weeks now our readings, especially the Gospels, continue to tell us that Jesus is the bread of life who has pitched his tent among us and given us a marvellous dignity because now the human and the divine are united in Jesus. He is the perfect revelation of God and the perfect human response to God and so a vital faith relationship with

Him is key. We need to study his life and habitually aim to imitate him.

This Gospel focuses also on the Eucharist. Eucharist means thanksgiving. So filled with the Holy Spirit, we give thanks to God for inviting us to share in His Wisdom, and in the Body and Blood of it. In our first reading today, God Himself who is Wisdom, invites us to His banquet. However, only those who are humble accept of this invitation. In their pride the Jews in today's Gospel refused to be fools in order to be made wise in the ways of God. By this they shut themselves out of the banquet of the Body and Blood of Christ. The mystery of the Eucharist is beyond human understanding. It is a mystery to be reverenced rather than a problem to be solved. Let us come to the Eucharist with reverence believing in the interest and love that Jesus has for us. He, in the Eucharist, can make a way when there is no way.


