Dear Parishioners and visitors to the Parish,

Jesus responds very differently to the two groups of people in today's Gospel. The first group—the apostles—have just returned from their mission and are very tired, so he says to them 'come away to a deserted place and rest for a while'. They still had much to learn but Jesus knows that their primary need at that time was rest. The second group—the crowds—are lost and dejected. They are seeking something from Jesus so he sets about to teach them at length. A priest today can face a similar situation as he looks out at his congregation on a Sunday morning. Present are people who may be tired and simply need to rest in the Lord. They don't need many words. Then there are others who are lost and dejected, who are hungry for God's work, who desire some input, some teaching. In some way the needs of both groups have to be honoured.

BIBLE SUNDAY

Today is Bible Sunday and so it is good to ask the question, what is the place of the Gospels in our lives?

St John of the Cross says that we will grow significantly in our relationship with Jesus as we study his life and make it a habit to aim to live his values and attitudes which would include saying no to values contrary to Gospel ones.

So, you are encouraged to join a lectio group or to read prayerfully the next week's Sunday Gospel during the week and ask yourself what does that Gospel passage mean for me and my family?

Two Gospel attitudes expressed by Mother Teresa of Calcutta:

Love: "Spread love everywhere you go, first of all in your own house. Give love to your children, to your wife or husband, to a next door neighbour. Let no one ever come to you without leaving better and happier. Be the living expression of God's kindness; kindness in your face, kindness in our eyes, kindness in your smile, kindness in your warm greeting."

Gratitude: At the end of each day Mother Teresa lived an attitude of gratitude. She would ponder in her heart all the good things God had done for her that day and would reflect on how she was or was not fully responding to his love. What are you grateful for today and how have your responded to that goodness? Teresa made it a habit to have an attitude of gratitude.

World Youth Skills Day

In November 2014, the United Nations declared July 15 as World Youth Skills Day.

The day recognises that young people are almost three times more likely to be unemployed than adults and continuously exposed to lower quality of jobs, greater labour market inequalities, and longer and more insecure school-to-work transitions. Education and training are key determinants of success in the labour market. However, existing systems often fail to address the learning needs of many young people.

Surveys of learning outcomes and skills show that a large number of youth have low levels of achievement in basic literacy and numeracy.

World Youth Skills Day aims to create greater awareness of the importance of vocational education, training, and the development of skills – locally and globally.
