Dear Parishioners and visitors to the Parish,

The Prophet Amos in this Sunday's readings expresses God's vehement rejection on unjust business practices that exploit poor people. God declares to people who have cheated others, 'Never will I forget a single thing you have done'.

In the Gospel passage we hear a sequence of wisdom advice about how to deal with wealth. First, Jesus tells a parable about a man dealing astutely with worldly goods to suggest that Christians need to be just as astute dealing with their spiritual lives. In the parable, a man who has been caught out in corrupt practices and so is given notice. However he is very shrewd in dealing with those who owe the rich man money. He shows favour to them in order to receive favours later.

Jesus does not encourage us to cheat! He wants us to realise that we must take serious responsibility for our spiritual welfare and that our actions have real consequences for our relationships with God. We need to have things in correct proportion, money should serve our relationships with others and above all with God.

It is the poor and those who care about them who will joyfully sign the Psalm response, 'Praise the Lord who lifts up the poor'.


Attention Alpha Participants Alpha Pauses over the **School Holidays**




SOCIAL JUSTICE CORNER:

International Day of Peace

Each year the International Day of Peace is observed around the world on 21 September. The United Nations has declared this as a day devoted to strengthening the ideals of peace, both within and among all nations and peoples.

The theme for 2019 is "Climate Action for Peace." The theme draws attention to the importance of combating climate change as a way to protect and promote peace throughout the world. Climate change causes clear threats to international peace and security. Natural disasters displace three times as many people as conflicts, forcing millions to leave their homes and seek safety elsewhere. The salinisation of water and crops is endangering food security, and the impact on public health is escalating. The growing tensions over resources and mass movements of people are affecting every country on every continent. On the 23rd September, the United Nations is convening a Climate Action Summit with concrete and realistic plans to accelerate action to implement the Paris Agreement. The Summit will focus on the heart of the problem – the sectors that create the most emissions and the areas where building resilience could make the biggest difference - as well as provide leaders and partners the opportunity to demonstrate real climate action and showcase their ambition. "It is possible to achieve our goals, but we need decisions, political will and transformational policies to allow us to still live in peace with our own climate."
