He makes his sun rise on the bad and the good, and causes rain to fall on the just and the unjust. (Gospel)

Dear Parishioners and visitors to the Parish,

On a compass, east is the farthest point from west and they will never meet. The Psalmist uses similar

imagery to show how far our forgiving God removes our transgressions from us. Still, the people need to remember the second great commandment of loving their neighbour. Rather than bearing grudges or having hearts full of hatred, they are called to be holy because God is holy. Paul puts this another way, reminding them that they are temples of the Holy Spirit in which God dwells. They belong to Christ and are to treat one another reverently.

Jesus knows that violence can spiral dangerously out of control. He teaches the people how it can be overcome—pay back good for evil, pray for those who wrong you, turn the other cheek, go the extra distance in helping someone, lend and give generously without expecting anything. Jesus reminds them that in doing these things they are responding as children of their compassionate and merciful Father.

These readings are still relevant. We are saddened and disturbed by the violence and cruelty in our society. As a follower of Christ, and a child of God, am I able to show I take Jesus' teaching to heart by loving, reverencing and serving my neighbour?

RELICS OF ST THERESE AND HER PARENTS LOUIS AND ZELIE MARTIN AT CORPUS CHRISTI CHURCH ON THE 5TH AND 6TH MARCH

St Therese was born in 1873, became a nun in the Carmel of Lisieux at the age of 15 and died at the very young age of 24. Pope Pius X said that she is one of the great saints of modern times. Her approach to Jesus was very effective in enabling her to have a deep friendship with God and it is applicable to all walks of life. Also she does not require extraordinary penances.

She shows us how we may come to God in our ordinary everyday life. She did not experience extraordinary phenomena such as visions or levitation. So she relates to you and me. Key to her approach is her appreciation that God is a God of mercy and embraces us even in our weakness.

She says that "Holiness is a disposition of heart that makes us humble and little conscious of our weakness but confident in God to the point of audacity." She invites us to make little acts of love out of love for God in a way that cares for our family and others. A parent getting up in the middle of the night to attend a sick child would exemplify this. It costs but it is an act of love in the concrete circumstance.

ZELIE & LOUIS MARTIN PARENTS OF THERESE

Zelie and Louis Martin were the first married couple to be canonized by the Church. They lived lives that are surprisingly similar to our contemporaries. Both were working while they raised their children. They were always busy. They knew the joys and sorrows of ordinary families. They died of illnesses familiar to us. Zelie of breast cancer and Louis of arteriosclerosis that affected his brain and meant that he was in a psychiatric hospital for three years.





"In My Blood It Runs" Screening

The insightful documentary "In My Blood It Runs" will be screening on Wednesday, 22nd April at 6:30pm at Roseville Cinema. The screening is a special fundraiser for "Children's Ground", a charity working to end disadvantage in Indigenous communities. A Q&A will be held after the film.

Ten-year-old Dujuan is a child-healer, a good hunter and speaks three languages. As he shares his wisdom of history and the complex world around him we see his spark and intelligence. Yet Dujuan is 'failing' in school and facing increasing scrutiny from welfare and the police.

As he travels perilously close to incarceration, his family fight to give him a strong Arrernte education alongside his western education lest he becomes another statistic. We walk with him as he grapples with these pressures, shares his truths and somewhere in-between finds space to dream, imagine and hope for his future self.

As the film is released, In My Blood It Runs will be working with a range of national partners to deliver an impact campaign that has been strategized in close consultation with Dujuan and his family as well as an advisory group of senior Arrernte and Garrwa Elders and leaders.

Members of the Corpus Christi Social Justice Group will be attending the screening. The event is being hosted by Jews for Social Action, Roseville Uniting Church and the Reconciliation Network, Northern Sydney Region. Tickets are \$25 plus a \$2 booking fee.
