"To you who hear, I say, love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you." (Gospel)

Dear Parishioners and Visitors to the Parish,

Today's Gospel is a continuation of the Beatitudes according to Luke. They are considered as part of the

hard sayings of Jesus. They do not make sense if taken literally but make eminent sense when considered in a nuances and deeper way.

A teacher asked her class, 'If you were arrested and charged by a hostile regime with being a Christian, would there be enough evidence to convict you?' This prompted a discussion on what would constitute compelling evidence. There was general agreement that anyone whose life bore witness to the teaching of Jesus proclaimed in today's Gospel would not have a leg to stand on. Even for us, who claim to be committed Christians, Jesus' commands that we should love our enemies and lend without any hope of return go against the grain and are not easy to respond to with much enthusiasm. They are what New Testament scholars sometimes refer to as the 'hard sayings' of Jesus.

Discipleship on these terms is costly but not impossible. We have the example of Jesus himself who practised what he preached and of many of his saintly followers. Three years before his martyrdom in Algeria in 1996, French Cistercian Father Christian de Cherge wrote a letter 'wholeheartedly forgiving whoever (his) killer might be' and praying, 'May we meet each other again, happy thieves, in paradise, should it please God."
