

To mark Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Catholic Sunday (2nd July), **all are invited** after Mass to hear an address by Susan Moylan-Coombes, followed by tea, coffee and refreshments.

Susan is the founding director of Gaimaragal Group, a company established to create a



new story of connection and wellbeing for all Australians. The group's aim is to facilitate the voice for indigenous Elders in the contemporary social space, empower youth to realise their full potential, and provide two-way cultural translation to bring individuals and communities together.

Susan's ancestry is Woolwonga and Gurindji from the Northern Territory and is part of a group known as the Stolen Generations. Susan has extensive experience in consultation with indigenous groups and the community as a whole and previously held the positions of Executive Producer ABC's Indigenous Programs Unit and Head of Production, NITV a division of SBS. Susan contributes her time to a number of boards and committees including Northern Sydney Local Health District Aboriginal Advisory Committee and founder and co-chair of the Guringai Festival Committee.

- It is for you that I suffer taunts, that shame covers my face, that I have become a stranger to my brothers, an alien to my own mother's sons. I burn with zeal for your house and taunts against you fall on me. (R.)
- This is my prayer to you, my prayer for your favour. In your great love, answer me, O God, with your help that never fails: Lord, answer, for your love is kind; in your compassion, turn towards me. (R.)
- The poor when they see it will be glad and God-seeking hearts will revive; for the Lord listens to the needy and does not spurn his

servants in their chains. Let the heavens and the earth give him praise, the sea and all its living creatures. (R.)

Second Reading

From the letter of St Paul to the Romans Rom 5:12-15

God's gift to us is nothing like our sin against him. Sin entered the world through one man, and through sin death, and thus death has spread through the whole human race because everyone has sinned. Sin existed in the world long before the Law was given. There was no law and so no one could be accused of the sin of 'law-breaking', yet death reigned over all from Adam to Moses, even though their sin, unlike that of Adam, was not a matter of breaking a law.

Adam prefigured the One to come, but the gift itself considerably outweighed the fall. If it is certain that through one man's fall so many died, it is even more certain that divine grace, coming through the one man, Jesus Christ, came to so many as an abundant free gift.

From the holy Gospel according to Matthew Mt 10:26-33

Do not fear those who can kill the body.

Jesus instructed the Twelve as follows: 'Do not be afraid. For everything that is now covered will be uncovered, and everything now hidden will be made clear. What I say to you in the dark, tell in the daylight; what you hear in whispers, proclaim from the house-tops.

'Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul; fear him rather who can destroy both body and soul in hell. Can you not buy two sparrows for a penny? And yet not one falls to the ground without your Father knowing. Why, every hair on your head has been counted. So there is no need to be afraid; you are worth more than hundreds of sparrows.

'So if anyone declares himself for me in the presence of men, I will declare myself for him in the presence of my Father in heaven. But the one who disowns me in the presence of men, I will disown in the presence of my Father in heaven.'
