Jesus answered, "You say I am a king. For this I was born and for this I came into the world, to testify to the truth." (Gospel)

Dear Parishioners and Visitors to the Parish.

The last Sunday of the liturgical year marks the observance of the Solemnity in honour of Jesus Christ, King of the universe. What is special about this feast?

1. Jesus is truly the King of the universe. When Pilate asked, 'So you are King?' Jesus replied: 'You say that I am King. For this I was born, and for this I have come into the world.' The Book of Revelation says, 'He is the ruler of the kings on earth'. Prophet Daniel and other prophets had longforetold the kingship of Jesus.

2. Jesus' kingship is not of this world. He existed from eternity. It was through him that the universe was created and, as such, all things belong to him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion.

3. He rules not by power or authority, armies and weapons, but by merciful love and humble service, by patient suffering and sacrificial death, by benevolent compassion and unconditional forgiveness. The object of his rule of love is the human heart. His throne is the cross and his crown is made of thorns. The law of his kingdom is the law of love. How loyal are we to our King and Lord, Jesus Christ?
