DAY OF REMEMBRANCE FOR ALL VICTIMS OF CHEMICAL SAFETY

This Sunday marks the Day of Remembrance for All Victims of Chemical Safety. On the 29th April each year the world pauses to remember the victims of chemical warfare.

The Day of Remembrance is particularly timely this year given recent events in Syria. Pope Francis has condemned the use of chemical weapons after a deadly attack killed dozens of innocent men, women and children in Douma, located north of the Syrian capital, Damascus: "There is no good and bad war, and nothing, nothing can justify the use of such instruments of extermination against defenseless people and populations." Pope Francis has encouraged us to pray "for all the dead, for the wounded, for the families who suffer" and called for world leaders to abandon the use of war as a means of gaining peace and stability.
