# Fr Abraham, have pity on me. Send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue. (Gospel)

Dear Parishioners and visitors to the Parish,

Amos was a prophet of the eighth century before Jesus, living a century before the Exile when the Temple was destroyed. Amos warns people who live a decadent lifestyle which exploits poor people that punishments written into the Jewish law are coming for them because their way of

living breaks God's law.

Jesus also speaks about decadent living in which fellow human beings can be left to live like dogs. To a group of people whom Luke had just described as 'lovers of money' (Luke 16:14), Jesus tells a parable about a rich man and a poor man who are impossibly far apart economically and socially. In the parable, there is an impassable gulf between both men, both in life on earth and in their life after death. The rich man expects to be favoured after death as he was in life but the same kind of gulf that he allowed between himself and the poor man now exists between them in death. We must do the good we can, while we can; we cannot allow luxury to delude us into allowing others to live inhuman lives.

In the Psalm we praise God who is just, feeds the hungry and sets prisoners free.




## **Attention Alpha Participants Alpha Pauses over** the School Holidays

The office will be closed on Monday 30 September and Monday 7 October 2019. We will be open from 9am-12nn on Tuesdays to Fridays during this time.



#### Social Justice Sunday

Today is Social Justice Sunday. The Australian Catholic Bishops have published a Social Justice Statement, titled: *Making it Real: Genuine human encounter in our digital world.* 

The Statement affirms the positive possibilities for encounter and solidarity offered by new digital media, while warning of those elements of our digital world that may be harmful. Pope Francis challenges to us to 'boldly become citizens of the digital world' actively shaping it.

Prayer for Our Digital World Lord, make us instruments of your peace.

Help us to recognise the evil latent in a communication that does not build communion.

Help us to remove the venom from our judgements.

Help us to speak about others as our brothers and sisters.

You are faithful and trustworthy; may our words be seeds of goodness for the world: where there is shouting, let us practise listening;

where there is confusion, let us inspire harmony;

where there is ambiguity, let us bring clarity; where there is exclusion, let us offer solidarity; where there is sensationalism, let us use sobriety:

where there is superficiality, let us raise real questions;

where there is prejudice, let us awaken trust; where there is hostility, let us bring respect; where there is falsehood, let us bring truth. Amen.
