Facilitating a child's faith formation is a rewarding experience that does not require a teacher's degree or an advanced degree in theology: all it requires is enthusiasm, as well as generosity in sharing your time with others.

SOCIAL JUSTICE SUNDAY

This weekend we are celebrating Social Justice Sunday. The Australian Catholic Bishops' Social Justice Statement for 2020–21 is titled *To Live Life to the Full: Mental health in Australia Today*. It encourages faith communities, governments and each one of us, to make mental health a priority. It is a timely message in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic. The pandemic is affecting many members of our parishes, schools and communities. Understanding mental health will help us to be aware of those who need our support. The Statement encourages us all to reject stigmatisation, to work for the transformation of social determinants of mental ill-health, and to call for policies and service provision that meets the needs of the poorest and most marginalised members of our community.

May we build communities of welcome and inclusion.

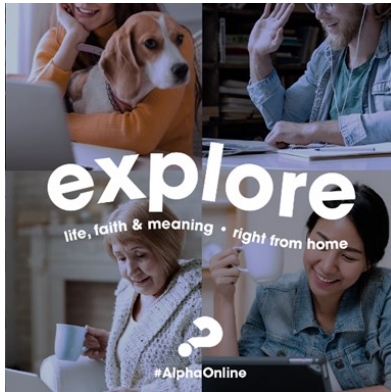
