But when Peter saw how strong the wind was he became frightened; and, beginning to sink, he cried out, "Lord, save me!" (Gospel)

**Dear Parishioners** 

Peter steps out of his boat into the troubled waters of life. Feeling the sudden force of the wind, he is afraid, experienced fisherman though he is.

We can identify with Peter as we recall times of discouragement, disappointment, or frustration, when we knew the need to move forward and yet were hopelessly stuck. In the first reading, Elijah is overcome with fear and goes into hiding. He hears the voice of God telling him to go to Mt Horeb. There he will meet God. On the mountain he finds that God is not in the earthquake, or the fire, or the storm, but in a gentle breeze. When a breeze arrives, he covers his face for he knows God is present! Peter, in the storm's violence, hears Jesus' gentle reproach about his doubt and lack of faith. This same gentleness is in God's word that echoes in our hearts in difficult moments. Instead of listening to our panic, our fear and our doubts, let us tune in to the gentle, personal, encouraging word that God is speaking in our hearts: 'Courage! It is I! Do not be afraid!'




## THE RIGHT OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)

#### **BLANKET APPEAL FOR TIBETAN REFUGEES**

The Social Justice Group will be holding the annual appeal for blankets, doonas and doona covers on the weekend of the 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> August. The donated goods will be distributed to Tibetan refugees who have arrived in the last 12 months on the Northern Beaches. All donations are welcome and will make a big difference to the lives of the refugees who, due to the cost of electricity, are unable to afford heaters, electric blankets etc.

It would be appreciated if donations are securely packed in a plastic bag or garbage bag. The Social Justice Group is only able to accept donations of blankets, doonas and doona covers. Clothing and other bed linen are not required.

Unfortunately, the annual raffle to raise funds to purchase prescription medication, health aids, and provide emergency assistance for newly arrived Tibetan refugees, has been postponed due to COVID-19. However, donations can be made to:

#### **COVID—Strong recommendation to wear masks**

As many would already be aware, on Sunday 2 August the Premier, along with the Chief medical officer announced the strong recommendation to wear masks in the following situations:

- in indoor settings where physical distancing is hard to maintain, such as on public transport or in supermarkets
- in indoor settings with a higher risk of transmission, such as for the staff of hospitality and customer-facing venues i.e. cafes, restaurants, pubs and clubs
- during attendance at places of worship.

Please note that at this stage, it is not a mandate and does not replace any other COVID-19 safe practices, such as social distancing.
